



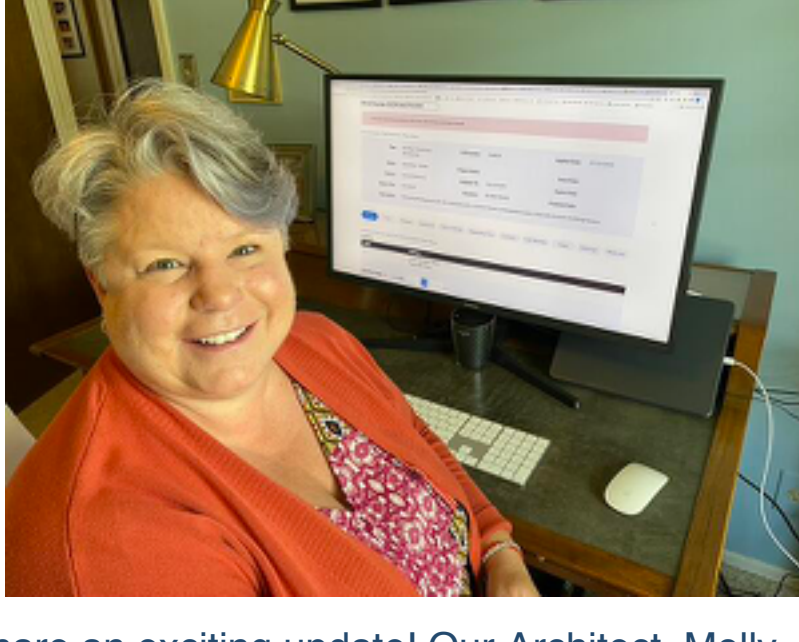

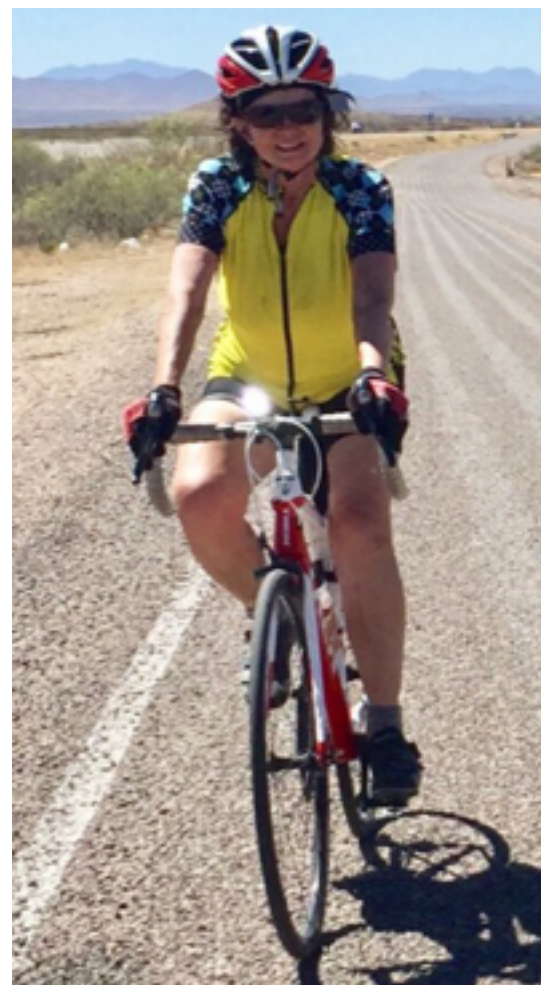
### How Can You Leave Your Home?
